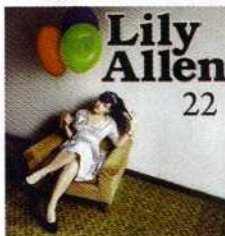

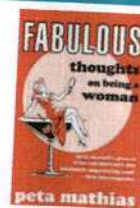
arm and a leg. And you don't need Gerard whispering sweet nothings in your ear. ★★ ★ ★ ★
